This case came up for settlement before the Lok Adalat. Both the parties present. The counsel for the appellant Mr.G.Prabhu Rajadurai and the counsel for the first respondent Mr.L.Siva, are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties and with the assistance of the Bench, both sides consented for settlement.



AWARD



Aggrieved by the Award passed by the Tribunal, the appellant/ Insurance Company has filed the present appeal.

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Now, both the parties appeared and the claimant agreed to receive the award amount in the following terms:-

The appellant/Insurance Company is agreed to pay a sum of Rs.5,50,000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs and Fifty Thousand only) in full quit and also undertakes to deposit the remaining amount within a period of four weeks from today.

The appellant/Insurance Company agreed for the said terms. On such deposit, the first respondent/claimant is entitled to withdraw the award amount of Rs.5,50,000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs and Fifty Thousand only) in full quit on filing necessary application before the Tribunal. The remaining portion of award remains intact.
