## **ORDER**

This Criminal Original Petition has been filed seeking to quash the charge sheet in C.C.No.174 of 2022 on the file of the Principal District Munsif Cum Judicial Magistrate Court, Thiruppathur, Sivagangai District.

2.The contention of the petitioners is that based on the complaint lodged by the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent, the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent registered the First Information Report in Crime No.111 of 2022 for the offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 448, 323 IPC and Section 4 of TN Prohibition of Harassment of Women Act, 2002, against the petitioners. It appears that it is a issue between the family members.



3.The further contention of the petitioners is that they compromised the issue with the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent amicably. A joint memo of compromise was filed, which has been duly signed by the petitioners and the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent and also by their respective counsels.

4.The petitioners and the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent appeared before this Court along with their counsels and also produced their Aadhar cards. They were also identified by the learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) and the Investigation Officer. Both the parties were enquired by me and they accepted the terms of compromise. Hence, the Compromise Memo is recorded.

5.Considering the totality of the circumstances, the nature of the allegations levelled against the petitioners and also in view of the joint compromise memo, dated 06.12.2023, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose will be served by keeping the matter pending. Hence, all further proceedings in C.C.No.174 of 2022 pending on the file of the Principal District Munsif Cum Judicial Magistrate Court, Thiruppathur, Sivagangai District, is quashed and the compromise memo is recorded.

Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petition is closed.
