ORDER

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondents 1 and 2 submitted that on the basis of the representation



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made by the petitioner dated 20.08.2023 and 25.08.2023, enquiry is undertaken. During the course of enquiry, both the parties appeared and had given an undertaking that they will not make any trouble to each other. On the basis of the above said undertaking given by both parties, the representation was closed.

5.In view of the above, nothing survives for further adjudication in this matter. Hence, this writ petition is dismissed as infructuous. No costs.
