PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No. 181 of 2023 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner / accused apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent



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police for the offences punishable under sections 394 and 398 IPC in Crime No.181

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of 2023 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner herein has trespassed into the TASMACH shop, in which the defacto complainant is working as a salesman and demanded money from the defacto complainant. When the same was refused by the defacto complainant, he has abused him in filthy language and also threatened him with dire consequences. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is innocent and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and his name has been falsely implicated in this case and hence, he seeks anticipatory bail.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) would submit that it is a second anticipatory bail petition and the investigation of the case pending and hence, he strongly, opposed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

5. Considering the serious nature of offence committed by the petitioner and also submission made by the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent and that there is no change of circumstances after dismissal of the earlier petition in Crl.O.P(MD).No.17653 of 2023, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.



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6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
