PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

Prayer in CRL OP(MD). 22724/ 2022 :

to enlarge the petition on the Anticipatory Bail in the event of Arrest to the petitioner in Crime No.Not Known of 2022 on the file of the Inspector of Police, Thiruparankundram Police Station, Madurai District.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 420 and 506(i) IPC in Crime No.Not known of 2022, seek anticipatory bail.

2.Today, when the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent Police submitted that petition enquiry against the petitioners is pending in current paper.



3. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate (Crl. side) for the respondent.

4. Considering the facts and circumstances, the respondent police has to issue notice under Section 41(A) of Cr.P.C to the petitioners and the petitioners are directed to appear before the respondent police and the Investigating Officer has to conduct the enquiry by strictly following the procedures therein and if any *prima facie* case is made out against the petitioners, register the F.I.R or close the petition enquiry within a period of two weeks from today. The parties are directed to cooperate with the enquiry. It is needless to say that the respondent police shall not take any coercive steps to secure the accused till the completion of enquiry on the complaint lodged by the de-facto complainant.

5. With the above directions, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
