To suspend the sentence passed in order dated 09/07/2019 passed in C.A.No.32 of 2018 on the file of the Additional District and Sessions Judge(FTC) Kumbakonam, Confirming the order dated 11/06/2018 passed in S.T.C.NO.3287 of 2012 on the file of the Judicial Magistrate No.2, Kumbakonam thereby convicting the petitioner u/s 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act and sentenced the petitioner to undergo simple imprisonment for a period of two year and also ordered the petitioner to pay compensation of Rs.5,00,000/- to the respondent/complainant.

Prayer in CRL RC(MD). 175/ 2020 :

To call for records with respect to the order dated 09/07/2019 passed in C.A.No.62 of 2018 on the file of the Additional District and Sessions Judge(FTC) Kumbakonam, Confirming the order dated 11/06/2018 passed in S.T.C.NO.3287 of 2012 on the file of the Judicial Magistrate No.2, Kumbakonam thereby convicting the petitioner u/s 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act and sentenced the petitioner to undergo simple imprisonment for a period of two year and also ordered the petitioner to pay compensation of Rs.5,00,000/- to the respondent/complainant.

Order : This petition coming up for orders on this day, upon perusing the petition filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of M/S.PRAKASH R, Advocate for the petitioner and of Mr.K.GUHAN, Advocate for Respondent the court made the following order:-
