PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No. 136 of 2023 on the file of the Respondent Police

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/accused, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent



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police for the offences punishable under sections 4(1)(i), 4(1)(a), 4(1-A) of Tamil Nadu Prohibition Act, in Crime No.136 of 2023 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the when the respondent police was in routine check up, the petitioner herein illegally found in possession of 4 liters of brandy in plastic cane by adding atropine for more intoxication. Hence, the case.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is innocent and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and his name has been falsely implicated in this case.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent would submit that when the respondent police was in routine check up, the petitioner herein illegally found in possession of 4 liters of brandy in plastic cane by adding atropine for more intoxication and on seeing police, he fled away from the scene of occurrence hence, he strongly opposed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.



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5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the serious nature of allegations made against the petitioner, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
