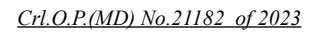
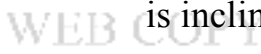
ORDER

This Criminal Original Petition had been filed to direct the learned Judge, Special Court for Exclusive Trial of Cases under SC/ST(POA) Act 1989, Ramanathapuram to consider the petitioners bail applications on the same day of surrender in Crime no.268 of 2023.

2.The petitioners are accused in Crime No.268 of 2023 on the file of the 2nd respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 452, 324, 427 IPC and Sections 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s), 3(2)(va) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989.

3.Mr.M.Vaikkam Karunanithi, learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) accepts notice for the respondents 1 and 2 and submitted that the second petitioner is having two previous cases of assault nature in his credit.

4.Considering the bad antecedents of the second petitioner, this petition stands dismissed with respect to the second petitioner.

2) On such surrender along with notice served to the defacto complainant, the concerned Judge shall consider the bail application filed by the petitioners A1, A3, A4 and pass orders on merits on the same day of their surrender; after hearing the defacto complainant by complying with Section 15A(3) of the Act.
