ORDER

This petition has been filed to direct the learned Additional Session Judge, (PCR) Court, Karur, to accept the surrender of the petitioners and consider their bail application on the same day on merits in relating to Crime No.488 of 2023, dated 08.06.2023 on the file of the respondent Police..

2.The petitioners are the accused persons in Crime No.488 of 2023 on the file of the 2nd respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 294(b), 323, 324, 506(ii) IPC r/w. Sections 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s) and 3(2)(Va) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989.

3.Mr.M.Vaikkam Karunanithi, learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) accepts notice for the respondents 1 and 2. He would further submitted that there is only simple injury in this case, no previous case is



pending against the petitioners and it is a case and counter case.

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4.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to pass the following orders :-

1)The petitioners shall appear before the learned Additional Session Judge, (PCR) Court, Karur, within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

2)On such surrender along with notice served to the defacto complainant, the concerned Judge shall consider the bail application filed by the petitioners and pass orders on merits on the same day of their surrender, after hearing the defacto complainant by complying with Section 15A(3) of the Act.

5.With the above observation, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
