ORDER

This petition has been filed to direct the learned II Additional District and Session Judge, (PCR), Tirunelveli, to consider the bail application of the petitioner in connection with the FIR in Crime No. 277/2023 on the file of 2nd respondent Police on the very same date of the surrender of the petitioner and consequently, to enlarge the petitioner on bail on the very same day itself by disposing the petitioner's bail application.

2.The petitioner is the accused persons in Crime No.277 of 2023 on the file of the 2nd respondent Police for the offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 324, 506(ii) of IPC @ 294(b), 324, 506(ii) IPC and Sections 3(1)(r) and 3(2)(Va) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Amendment Act, 2015.

3.Mr.M.Vaikkam Karunanithi, learned Additional Public Prosecutor, accepts notice for the respondents 1 and 2. He would submit



that the petitioner has no previous case and the injured is discharged from the hospital on 24.08.2023.

4.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to pass the following orders :-

- 1)The petitioner shall appear before the learned
II Additional District and Session Judge,
(PCR), Tirunelveli, within a period of 15 days
from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
- 2) On such surrender along with notice served
to the defacto complainant, the concerned
Judge shall consider the bail application filed
by the petitioner and pass orders on merits on
the same day of their surrender, after hearing
the defacto complainant by complying with
Section 15A(3) of the Act.

5.With the above observation, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
