2.The case of the prosecution is that due to previous enmity between the parties, the accused persons have trespassed into the house of the de-facto complainant and abused the de-facto complainant and her minor daughter in filthy language and also the petitioner herein had lifted his lungi in front of the minor girl. Hence, the case.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is innocent and a false case has been foisted against him. Hence, he seeks anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

4.The learned Government Advocate (crl.side) appearing for the respondent submitted that due to previous enmity between the parties, the accused persons have trespassed into the house of the de-facto complainant and abused the de-facto complainant and her minor daughter in filthy language and also the petitioner herein had lifted his lungi in front of the minor girl. She strongly oppose to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
