2.The petitioners are the accused persons in Crime No.600 of 2023 on the file of the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 294(b), 324 and 427 of IPC and Section 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s) and 3(2)(va) of SC/ST (POA) Amendment Act, 2015.

3.Mr.M.Vaikkam Karunanithi, learned Government Advocate (Crl. side), accepts notice for the respondents 1 and 2. He would further submitted that the injured in this case has been discharged from the hospital. There is no previous case against the petitioners.

1)The petitioners shall appear before the learned District and Sessions Judge, (Special Court for PCR Cases), Pudukottai, within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

2)On such surrender along with notice served to the defacto complainant, the concerned Judge shall consider the bail application filed by the petitioners and pass orders on merits on the same day of their surrender, after hearing the defacto complainant by complying with Section 15A(3) of the Act.

5.With the above observation, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
