3.Mr.R.M.Anbunithi, learned Additional Public Prosecutor, accepts notice for the respondents 1 and 2. He would further submit that the injured in this case has been discharged from the hospital. He would further submitted that there were three previous cases registered against the petitioner. But all the cases were disposed of.



4.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to pass the following orders :-

- 1)The petitioner shall appear before the learned
III Additional District Judge, (PCR Court),
Madurai, within a period of 15 days from the
date of receipt of a copy of this order.
- 2)On such surrender along with notice served
to the defacto complainant, the concerned
Judge shall consider the bail application filed
by the petitioner and pass orders on merits on
the same day of his surrender, after hearing the
defacto complainant by complying with
Section 15A(3) of the Act.

5.With the above observation, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
