Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the 2nd Respondent in conducting a Physical Measurement Test (PMT), Physical Efficiency Test (PET) for the recently delivered petitioners herein starting from 10.12.2022 to

14.12.2022 on par with others as part of the direct recruitment for the posts of SCT SI Civil and/or Equivalent, SCT PC Civil and/or Equivalent, SCT PC IT and CO/Mechanic/Driver and Prohibition and Excise Constable without allowing representations from the Petitioners in which they made a request to conduct the events once they fit to participate after giving birth to a baby as illegal, arbitrary, discriminatory and violative of Art 14, 15(3), 16, 21 and 42 of Constitution of India and consequently Direct the 2nd Respondent to grant time to the Petitioners herein until they are fit and allow them to participate in the further selection process, without insisting on physical ability to complete the Physical Efficiency Test, in the interest of justice

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to Direct the 2nd Respondent to grant time to the Petitioners herein until they are fit and allow her to participate in the further selection process like Final Written Examination (FWE), without insisting on Physical Efficiency Test (PET)/Physical Measurement Test to complete, in the interest of justice and to have such other order or orders as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit, just and proper in the circumstances of the case.
