2. None appears on behalf of the petitioners. Perused the record.

3. The present petition is filed questioning the docket order summoning these petitioners to face trial and in view of evidence of LW1/PW1, procedure under Section 319 of Cr.P.C. is invoked.

4. There is no appearance on behalf of the petitioners. On perusal of proceeding sheet, no interim orders were granted by this Court earlier. Further, no details are provided regarding the present stage of the case in the trial Court. Unless the petitioners prosecute their case diligently, the cases cannot be

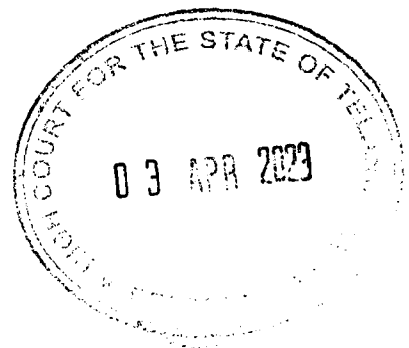
