Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an order or direction or writ more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus, declaring the action of the Respondent Nos.2 and 3 in not adding/ recording/incorporating the missing extent of land in Pattadar Passbook-cum-Title Deed Nos.T08130101012 of the petitioner No.1, to an extent of Ac.0.07 gts. and T08130101150 of the petitioner No.2, to an extent of Ac.0.20 gts., both in Sy.No.1288/EE8 of Ramayampet Village and Mandal, Medak District, as arbitrary, illegal, violative of principles of natural justice, contrary to the provisions of Telangana Rights in Land and Pattadar Passbooks Act, 1971 (Act 26/1971) and Rules made thereunder, contrary to the Telangana Rights in Land and Pattadar Passbooks Act, 2020 (Act 9/2020), CCLA's Circular No.1/2021, dt.15.01.2021 and violative of Article 14, 21, 300A of Constitution of India and to direct the Respondent Nos.2 and 3 to add/record the missing extent of land in the petitioners respective Pattadar Passbook-cum-Title Deeds

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondent Nos. 2 & 3 to dispose the online applications vide Dharani Ref. Nos. 2200067528 and 2200067502 respectively, dt.14.07.2022 by recording the missing extent of Ac.0.0700 gts., and Ac.0.2000 gts., in Sy.No.1288/EE8 of Ramayampet village

and Mandal Medak District, in petitioners respective Pattadar Pass Book cum Title Deed Nos. T08130101012 and T08130101150, during the pendency of writ petition, in the interest of justice
