ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr.P.C.') by the petitioner-Accused No.4 seeking to quash the proceedings against him in C.C.No.10319 of 2021 pending on the file of the III Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate at Hyderabad.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent No.1 – State. Perused the record.

3. The petitioner is being prosecuted for the offence under Section 332 read with 34 of IPC, Section 4 of Medical Services Act. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners confines his prayer to direct the concerned Court to dispose off the main case as expeditiously as possible.
