This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr.P.C.') by the petitioner-Accused No.1 seeking to quash the proceedings against him in C.C.No.304 of 2015 pending on the file of XIII Additional Metropolitan Magistrate at Hyderabad, registered for the offences under Sections 498-A and 406 of Indian Penal Code and Sections 4 and 6 of Dowry Prohibition Act.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent – State. Perused the record.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the case is of the year 2015 and there is no progress in the matter even though seven (07) years have passed.

4. Considering the submission of learned counsel for the petitioner, without going into the facts of the case, this Court deems it appropriate to direct the concerned Court to dispose of the case as

expeditiously as possible within a period of four (04) months, in accordance with law by following the procedure under Section 309 of Cr.P.C.

5. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is disposed of.
