This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr.P.C.') by the petitioner-Accused No.2 to release the passport of the petitioner vide No.R6868698 for interim custody which is in the custody of the Metropolitan Sessions Judge, Cyberabad, Ranga Reddy District at L.B.Nagar.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent – State. Perused the record.

3. The petitioner filed the present application seeking return of the passport on the ground of his necessity to travel to London. The petitioner has filed an application before the Metropolitan Sessions Judge, Cyberabad, Ranga Reddy District at L.B.Nagar vide Crl.M.P.No.3271 of 2022 requesting the Court to return his passport for the purpose of his travel. However, the said petition is still pending.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner confining his prayer to direct the Metropolitan Sessions Judge to dispose of the said Crl.M.P. within a stipulated time.

5. In the said circumstances, the Criminal Petition is disposed off and the Metropolitan Sessions Judge, Cyberabad, Ranga Reddy District at L.B.Nagar is directed to dispose of the Crl.M.P.No.3271 of 2022 within a period of one week from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

Miscellaneous applications pending, if any, shall stand closed.
