CONTEMPT CASE No.273 of 2017

ORDER:

The contempt case is filed seeking to punish the respondent under Sections 10 to 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for deliberate and willful disobedience in implementing the order passed by this Court in W.P.No.39244 of 2016, dated 15.11.2016.

2. No representation on behalf of the petitioners in the morning and afternoon sessions. Heard learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue appearing on behalf of respondent.

3. This Court while disposing the writ petition i.e., W.P.No.39244 of 2016 on 15.11.2016, directed the 4th respondent to consider the application made by the petitioners on 17.09.2016 and pass necessary orders thereon, if the same is still pending consideration, in accordance with law, after hearing the petitioners and the aggrieved party, if any, as early as possible, preferably within a period of eight weeks from the from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

4. Learned Assistant Government Pleader basing on the instructions submits that, the respondent complied with the order passed by this Court in W.P.No.39244 of 2016, dated 15.11.2016.
5. In view of the above submission, no further adjudication is required.
6. Accordingly, the Contempt Case is closed. However, the petitioners are granted liberty to avail the remedies as are available under law, if so advised.

Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand closed.
