This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr.P.C.') by the petitioner/*de facto* complainant to quash the order dated 05.01.2023 passed in CrI.M.P.No.1904 of 2022 in C.C.No.10390 of 2021 on the file of XV Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Hyderabad at Manoranjan Complex, Nampally, Hyderabad.

2. Heard both sides.

3. The petitioner who is the wife of the 2nd respondent questioning the order of the learned Magistrate in CrI.M.P.No.1904 of 2022 in C.C.No.10390 of 2021, granting permission to 2nd respondent/Accused No.1 to travel to United Kingdom for a period of six(06) months. The learned Magistrate considering the facts of the case has permitted the 2nd respondent/Accused No.1 to travel U.K. for a period of six months by imposing conditions.

4. This case is of the year 2021. I do not find any irregularity and illegality in allowing the 2nd respondent/Accused No.1 to travel to U.K. on conditions. For which reason, there are no

grounds to quash the order dated 05.01.2023 passed in Crl.M.P.No.1904 of 2022 in C.C.No.10390 of 2021 on the file of XV Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Hyderabad at Manoranjan Complex, Nampally, Hyderabad.

5. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is dismissed.
