Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to quash the F.I.R.No.1897 of 2022 dated 08-12-2022 against the petitioner/Accused on the file of the P.S.Rajendra Nagar, Ranga Reddy District and pass such other order or orders may deem fit and proper in the circumstances of the case.

Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased grant stay of all further proceedings in F.I.R.No.1897 of 2022 dated 08.12.2022 against the petitioner/Accused on the file of the P.S.Rajendra Nagar, Ranga Reddy District and pass such other order or orders may deem fit and proper in the circumstances of the case.

This Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition and upon hearing the arguments of Sri MOHD IRSHAD AHMED, Advocate for the Petitioner and of the Assistant Public Prosecutor (TG) on behalf of the Respondent No.1 and of None Appeared for the Respondent No.2.

The Court made the following: ORDER

CRIMINAL PETITION No.530 OF 2023

ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr.P.C.') by the petitioner-Accused to quash the proceedings against him in FIR No.1897 of 2022 pending on the file of Station House Officer, Rajendranagar Police Station, Ranga Reddy District, filed for the offences punishable under Sections 417 and 420 of Indian Penal Code (for short "IPC").

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner – Accused and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent – State. Perused the material on record.

3. The 2nd respondent – *de facto* complainant filed a complaint stating that she was acquainted with the petitioner several years prior to her filing of complaint. It is alleged that the 2nd respondent had emotionally, spiritually and also supported the petitioner with money. However, the petitioner is now trying to marry someone else.

4. In the facts of the case, it appears that the present case is one of differences between the 2nd respondent and petitioner.

5. Keeping in view that there is no specific allegation attracting any of the ingredients under Section 420 of IPC, this Court deems it appropriate to direct the Investigating Officer in respect of FIR No.1897 of 2022 pending on the file of Station House Officer, Rajendranagar Police Station, Ranga Reddy District, to conclude the investigation without taking any coercive steps against the petitioner – Accused. Further, the petitioner – Accused shall co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when required for the purpose of investigation.

6. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is disposed of.

Miscellaneous applications pending, if any, shall stand closed.
