ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'Cr.P.C.') by the petitioners/accused Nos.1 to 3 to quash the proceedings against them in C.C. No.257 of 2021 on the file of learned XIII Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate at Hyderabad. The offences alleged against them are under Sections 498-A and 406 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC') and Sections 3 and 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent – State. Perused the record.

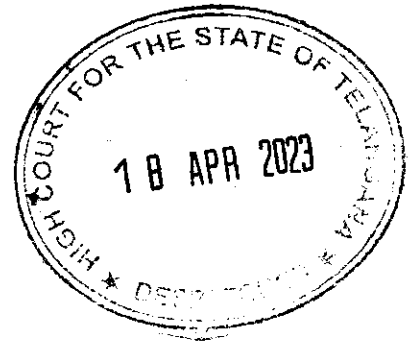
