Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS holding the action of the Respondents herein more particularly Respondent No.2 in issuing the impugned order vide - proceedings No.2995/TSEC-PR/Miryalagudem/GPs/ 2019(22), dt. 03/10/2020, as illegal, arbitrary, unjust and in violation of principles of natural justice and to consequently direct the Respondents herein to consider Petitioner's representation dt. 16/01/2020 in the interest of justice.

2. This Writ Petition is filed questioning the impugned Order dated 03.10.2020 passed by the respondent No.2 declaring the petitioner to be ineligible for a period of three years from the date of order to contest in any elections to be held in any office under Section 23 of Telangana Panchayath Raj Act, 2018 and as per Rule 106 (3) and 106 (7) of the Telangana Panchayath Raj (Conduct of Election) Rule, 2018.

3. As the above said period was elapsed, the cause in the Writ Petition does not survive and the Writ Petition has become infructuous.

4. Accordingly, this Writ Petition is dismissed as infructuous. No order as to costs.

5. As sequel to it, Miscellaneous Petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.

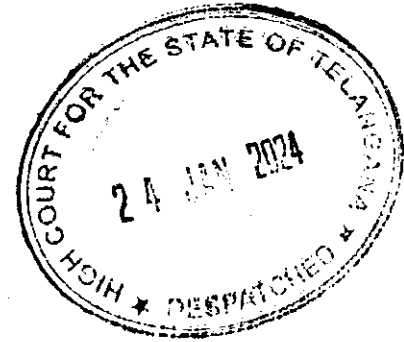
