Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, order or Direction more particularly in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondents 3 to 5 in non-considering the online application LM2300000207, dated 10.12.2022 of the petitioner and non-initiating to trace out missing land of the petitioner to an extent of Ac.0-11 guntas in Survey No.26/1/3, which is situated at Parpelly Revenue Village Sivar, Laxmichanda Mandal, Nirmal District, as illegal, arbitrary and violative of Articles 14, 15, 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India and also violative of Natural justice and consequently to direct the Respondents 3 to 5 to consider the online application LM2300000207, dated 10.12.2022 of the petitioner and to trace out missing land of the petitioner to an extent of Ac.0-11 guntas in Survey No.26/1/3, which is situated at Parpelly Revenue Village Sivar, Laxmichanda Mandal, Nirmal District, in the interest of justice;

ORDER:

Heard Sri Rapolu Bhaskar, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue appearing for respondents. Perused the record.

The petitioner is claiming that he is the absolute owner and possessor of lands admeasuring Ac.3-05 gts., in Sy.No.26/1/3 situated at Parpally revenue village Shivar, Laxmichanda mandal, Nirmal District. He is also owner of land in other survey numbers. Ac.0-11 gts., in Sy.No.26/1/3 is missing in the new pattedar pass books and title deeds. In proof of the same, he has filed copies of old and latest pattedar pass books and title deeds. He has submitted online application bearing No.LM2300000207 dated 10-12-2022 to respondent No.3 with a request to correct the said missing entry. Despite receiving and acknowledging the said online application,

respondent No.3 did not act upon the same, therefore, the present writ petition.

Whereas learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue, on instructions, would submit that respondent No.3 will consider the said online application submitted by the petitioner and pass appropriate orders, in accordance with law.

In view of the aforesaid discussion, this writ petition is disposed of, directing respondent No.3 to consider the online application bearing No.LM2300000207 dated 10-12-2022 submitted by the petitioner and pass appropriate orders, in accordance with law by putting the petitioner and all affected parties on notice and affording them an opportunity of hearing. If respondent No.3 is not inclined to accept the claim / request of the petitioner, he shall assign specific reasons, pass a reasoned order and shall communicate copy of the said order to the petitioner. He shall complete the entire exercise within a

period of eight (8) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel, the miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending in the Writ Petition shall stand closed.
