This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short "Cr.P.C") by the petitioner – accused to quash the proceedings against him in C.C.No.184 of 2013 pending on the file of learned XII Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, City Criminal Courts, Nampally, Hyderabad, filed for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 406 and 120(B) of the Indian Penal Code and Section 28 of A.P. Apartments (promotion of Construction and Ownership) Act, 1987.

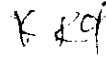
2. None appears on behalf of the petitioner. Perused the record.
