Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ order or direction particularly one in the nature of writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondents in not taking action on the application dated 09.04.2007 submitted by the petitioners forwarded by the 1st respondent through proceedings dated 24.04.2007 as illegal arbitrary and contrary to the provisions of Andhra Pradesh Scheduled areas land transfer regulation 1959 as amended by regulation I & II of 1970 and the Andhra Pradesh Schedule Area land transfer rules 1969 and consequently direct the 2nd respondent to consider the dispose the representation dated 09-04-2007 submitted by the petitioner and forwarded by the 4th respondent through the proceedings dated 24.04.2007 in accordance with law.

ORDER:

When the matter is taken up for hearing on 08.02.2023, learned counsel appearing on behalf of 5th respondent submits that 5th respondent died on 26.08.2011 and he furnished the particulars of the legal heirs and also filed memo vide USR No.97375 of 2022 on 01.11.2022 to the counsel for the petitioners. In spite of the same, the petitioners have not chosen to take steps to bring L.Rs of R-5. To give one opportunity to the petitioners, posted to 10.02.2023 under the caption 'for dismissal'. On 10.02.2023 also there was no representation on behalf of the petitioners. To give one more opportunity to the petitioners, posted to 14.02.2023.

2. But today also there is no representation on behalf of the petitioners in the morning and afternoon sessions.

3. In view of the same, it clearly shows that the petitioners are not having any interest to prosecute the matter.

4. Accordingly, the writ petition is dismissed for non-prosecution. There shall be no order as to costs. Miscellaneous applications, pending if any, shall stand closed.
