TIRUPATHI REDDY, Advocate for the Petitioner and the Public Prosecutor on  
behalf of the Respondent No.1 and none appeared for the Respondent No.2

**The Court made the following: ORDER**

**THE HONOURABLE SRI JUSTICE K.SURENDER****CRIMINAL PETITION No.831 OF 2023****ORDER:**

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr.P.C.') by the petitioner-Accused to quash the proceedings against him in C.C.No.359 of 2021 (arising out of Crime No.86 of 2021) pending on the file of Judicial First Class Magistrate at Dubbak, Siddipet District. The offences alleged against the petitioners are under Sections 448, 506 and 504 of Indian Penal Code (for short "IPC").

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent No.1 – State. Perused the record.

3. Though the petitioner has raised several grounds to quash the proceedings in the aforesaid case, learned counsel for the petitioner requested this Court to dispense with the appearance of the petitioner, in the aforesaid case before the trial Court.

4. In view of the aforesaid submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Criminal Petition is disposed off with the following directions:

i) The attendance of the petitioner – Accused is dispensed with in C.C.No.359 of 2021 (arising out of Crime No.86 of 2021) pending on the file of Judicial First Class Magistrate at Dubbak, Siddipet District, when represented by his counsel on record.

ii) The attendance of the petitioner is dispensed subject to filing an affidavit by the petitioner stating that in his absence the proceedings conducted by his counsel will not be disputed by him in any manner and shall not dispute his identity also.

iii) However, the petitioner shall appear before the learned Magistrate as and when his presence is required. In the event of the petitioner failure to appear when the Court directs, this order dispensing his attendance shall stand cancelled.

6. Needless to say, the petitioner is at liberty to file an application seeking discharge before the concerned Court. In the event of such application being made, the concerned Court shall

dispose it off on merits, within a period of four weeks from the date of filing.

Miscellaneous applications pending, if any, shall stand closed.
