The present Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking to quash the order dated 26.10.2015 passed in CrI.M.P.No.1132 of 2015 in S.C.No.126 of 2010 by the learned V Additional Metropolitan Sessions Judge, (Mahila Court), at Hyderabad and recall the PW's 1 to 3 for further cross examination in the interests of justice.

2. Heard Mr. S.M. Deshmukh, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Vizarith Ali, learned Assistant Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent State.

3. When the matter is taken up for hearing, learned Assistant Public Prosecutor by filing a copy of the order dated 14.12.2021 passed by this Court in CrI.P.No.9827 of 2015 submitted that the proceedings against the petitioner in S.C.No.126 of 2010 for the offences under Sections. 452, 354, 382, 506 & 509 I.P.C. on the file of the learned V Additional Metropolitan Sessions Judge, Nampally, Hyderabad are quashed. Therefore, seeks to dismiss the Criminal Petition as infructuous.

4. Mr. Vizarath Ali, learned Assistant Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent State concedes to the said request.

5. Recording the submissions made by both the learned counsel and on perusing the order dated 14.12.2021 passed by this Court in CrI.P.No.9827 of 2015, this Criminal Petition is dismissed as infructuous.

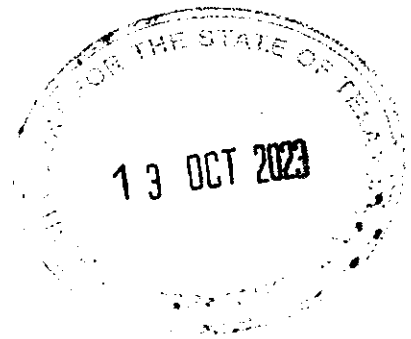
