Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to Quash the proceedings in CC No.153/2019 on the file of XIV Metropolitan Magistrate, Cyberabad at LB.Nagar, the alleged offence in Crime No. 53/2018 i.e., u/s. 498 (A). 324 I.P.C and Sec. 3 of D.P Act, against the petitioner/Accused No.4 in the interest of justice.

This Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition and upon hearing the arguments of Sri JANARDHAN GOUD, Advocate for the Petitioners and of the Additional Public Prosecutor for the State of Telangana on behalf of the Respondent No.1 and none appeared for R2.

The Court made the following: ORDER

THE HONOURABLE SRI JUSTICE K.SURENDER**CRIMINAL PETITION No.1367 OF 2023****ORDER:**

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr.P.C.') by the petitioners-Accused Nos.1 to 4 to quash the proceedings against them in C.C.No.153 of 2019 pending on the file of XIV Metropolitan Magistrate, Cyberabad at L.B. Nagar. The offences alleged against them are under Sections 498-A and 324 of Indian Penal Code and Section 3 of Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners – accused Nos.1 to 4 and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent – State. Perused the record.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners confined his prayer to dispense with the personal appearance of petitioners - Accused Nos.1 to 4.

4. Considering the submission of learned counsel for the petitioners, the attendance of the petitioners – Accused Nos.2 to 4 is dispensed with in C.C.No.153 of 2019 pending on the file of XIV

Metropolitan Magistrate, Cyberabad at L.B. Nagar, when represented by their counsel on record. The attendance of the petitioners is dispensed with subject to filing affidavits by the petitioners stating that in their absence the proceedings conducted by their counsel will not be disputed by them in any manner and shall not dispute their identity also. However, the petitioners shall appear before the learned Magistrate as and when their presence is required. In the event of failure of the petitioners to appear when the Court directs, this order dispensing their attendance shall stand cancelled. No such relief is given as far as petitioner No.1 – Accused No.1 is concerned.

5. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is disposed of. Needless to say, in the event of the petitioners filing an application seeking discharge, in the event of charges being not framed, the concerned Court shall dispose it of on merits within a period of four (04) weeks from the date of filing, after hearing arguments on both sides.

Miscellaneous applications pending, if any, shall stand closed.
