Writ Petition No.32970 of 2014

ORDER: *(Per Hon'ble Sri Justice Abhinand Kumar Shavili)*

When the matter is taken up for hearing, it is noticed that the present Writ Petition is filed by the petitioners aggrieved by the interlocutory order dated 15.07.2014 passed by the Andhra Pradesh Administrative Tribunal, at Hyderabad (for short, 'the Tribunal') in O.A.No.4215 of 2014.

2. Since the present Writ Petition is filed against the interlocutory order passed by the Tribunal in the above O.A., and the main O.A. was still pending before the Tribunal at that point of time, and now the said Tribunal has also been abolished, the O.A., if it is pending, be transferred to the High Court in the form of a transfer Writ Petition.

3. In view of above, this Court is not inclined to interfere with the interlocutory order passed by the Tribunal in O.A.No.4215 of 2014, dated 15.07.2014.

4. However, the petitioners are at liberty to pursue their remedies in the main case itself.

5. With these observations, the Writ Petition is dismissed.
No costs.

6. As a sequel, miscellaneous applications pending if any in this Writ Petition, shall stand closed.
