This Criminal Petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr.P.C.'), is filed by the petitioners-accused Nos.1 to 3 to quash the proceedings against them in C.C.No.1277 of 2017 pending on the file of Additional Judicial First Class Magistrate at Madhira, registered for the offences under Sections 447, 427, 379 read with 34 of Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC').

2. None appears for the petitioners. Perused the record.

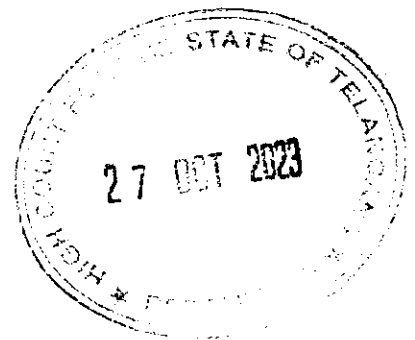
