The Court made the following: ORDER

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr.P.C.') by the petitioner - sole accused to quash the impugned proceedings against him in C.C.No.46 of 2015 in Crime No.214 of 2014 dated 08.07.2014 on the file of the learned XIII Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Nampally, Hyderabad. The offences alleged against the petitioner are under Sections 498-A, 406 of Indian Penal Code (for shot "IPC") and Sections 4 and 6 of Dowry Prohibition Act (for shot "D.P.Act").

2. None appears for the petitioner. Perused the record.
3. The crime is of the year 2014. The charge sheet was also filed in the year 2015. No interim orders were passed by this Court when the case was filed in the year 2019. The stage in the trial Court is not known.

4. I do not find any reason to keep this Criminal Petition pending.

5. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is disposed off. However, the petitioner is at liberty to approach this Court, in case any cause survives.

Miscellaneous applications pending, if any, shall stand closed.

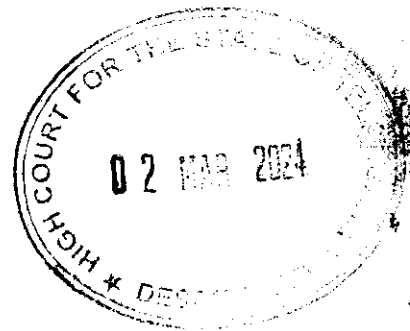
