Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue any writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS declaring the process of recruitment of Asst Public Prosecutors interms of the Notification Rc.No.42/Rect./Admn-2/2021, dated. 04/07/2021 and also the action in restricting the number of posts to 92 as against the advertised posts of 151, despite of availability of 130 selected candidates 2021 is arbitrary, illegal and violative of articles 14,15,16,19 and 21 of Indian constitution and contrary to the principle of reservation as enunciated by Rules and decided by the Apex court and other courts, while declaring the carry forward Rule of women Rule 22(2)(g) of Telangana State and Subordinate Service Rules - 1996 dated. as amended vide G.O.Ms.No.196 dated. 28/5/2016 as null and void direct the respondents to fill-up all the available vacancies with the qualified candidates in terms of notification with regards to the EWS, MSP, Women and BC sub categories as carry forward rule does not apply to the

subsequent year with all consequential and attendant benefits by keeping in view the purpose and urgency underlying the notification issued in terms of the orders of this court
