Family Court, City Civil Court, Hyderabad and pass such order or other orders as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the circumstances of the case.

Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to suspend the impugned interim order dt.11-01-2023 passed by the Honorable 1st Additional Family Judge, Family Court, City Civil Court, Hyderabad pending disposal of the main case and pass such order or other orders as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the circumstances of the case.

This Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition and upon hearing the arguments of Smt. G. Madhuri, Advocate for the Petitioner and the Additional Public Prosecutor (TG) on behalf of the Respondent No.1 and of Sri Chandra Shekar Reddy, Advocate for the Respondent Nos.2 to 4.

The Court made the following: ORDER

CRIMINAL PETITION No.2978 OF 2023

ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'Cr.P.C.') by the petitioner/respondent to quash the order dated 11.01.2023 in M.P.No.137 of 2022 in M.C.No.226 of 2022 on the file of learned I Additional Family Court, City Civil Court, Hyderabad.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner/respondent and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent - State. Perused the record.

3. The petitioner/husband is questioning the orders of the learned Family Judge in granting maintenance of Rs.30,000/- to the respondent No.4 herein, who is the second daughter namely Pinjala Keerthana.

4. As seen from the order at paragraph No.6d, the petitioner/husband was paying maintenance amount as

granted into the bank account of the wife and also bearing educational expenses and medical expenses.

5. In the said circumstances, this Court deems it appropriate to reduce the maintenance of Rs.30,000/- as ordered by the learned Magistrate to Rs.15,000/- to the 2nd daughter/respondent No.4. Further, the learned Family Judge is directed to dispose of the main case within a period of six (06) months, from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

4. With the above direction, the Criminal Petition is disposed of.

Miscellaneous applications pending, if any, shall stand closed.

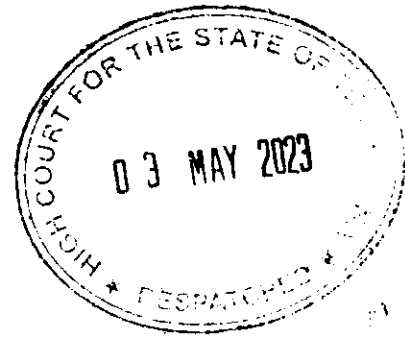
