Petition Under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to pass an order, direction or writ more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus declaring the action of the Respondent No.2 in not providing police aid for implementation of Common Judgment and Decree, Dated 30.11.2022 in O.S.No.178 of 2011 and O.S.No.570 of 2014 on the file of Senior Civil Judge, Nalgonda in respect of Plot admeasuring 1777.77 sq.ds in Sy.No.743, situated at Devarakonda Village and Mandal, Nalgonda District despite receiving a Representation Dated 04.03.2023 is illegal, arbitrary, unjustified and in violation of principles of natural justice and also violation of Article 14 (g) and 21 of Constitution of India consequently direct the Respondent No.2 to provide police aid to the above said property for implementation of the

Common Judgment and Decree, Dated 30.11.2022 in O.S.No.178 of 2011 and O.S.No.570 of 201.4 on the file of Senior Civil Judge, Nalgonda.
