Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus by declaring the action of the Respondents in not processing the individual applications for release of individual electricity connections to the individual portions of the petitioner's building in plot no. 8 in Sainath Enclave, in sy.no. 78, admeasuring 1044 sq.yds situated at Venkataramana Colony, Serilingampally Municipality, now under GHMC Serilingampally Circle, R.R.Dist. as illegal, arbitrary, unjust and consequently direct the respondents to process individual applications for providing individual electricity connections and to release individual service connections with meters to each portion without any further delay.

The Court made the following: ORDER

WRIT PETITION No.8128 of 2023

ORDER:

This Writ Petition is filed seeking a writ of mandamus by declaring the action of the respondents in not processing the individual applications for release of individual electricity connections to the individual portions of the petitioner's building in Plot No.8, in Sainath Enclave, in Sy.No.78 admeasuring 1044 Sq.yds situated at Venkataramana colony, Serilingampally Municipality now under GHMC Serilingampally Circle, Ranga Reddy District, as illegal and arbitrary and consequently to direct the respondents to process the applications for providing the individual electricity connections and to release service connections with meters to petitioner's property without any further delay and to pass such other order as orders.

2. Heard Mr.Sathvik Mukunur, learned counsel for the petitioner, Sri R.Vinod Reddy, learned Standing Counsel for TSSPDCL appearing for respondents No.1 to 3, and the Writ Petition is disposed of at admission stage with the consent of both the parties.

3. Learned Counsel for the petitioner submitted that the M/s.Aravinda Old Age Home managed by Sri Sai Aravinda Seva Trust by its managing trustee Mr.T.Pratap Reddy, S/o. Late Ramachandra Reddy, executed a relinquishment deed dated 17.10.2022 in favour of the petitioner with respect to Plot No.8, in Sainath Enclave, in

Sy.No.78 admeasuring 1044 Sq.yds situated at Venkataramana colony, Serilingampally Municipality now under GHMC Serilingampally Circle, Ranga Reddy District and the petitioner had applied for domestic electricity connection to the said property vide acknowledgment dated 17.02.2023 to the respondents. But as on this date, the respondents have not considered and given any power supply to the petitioner, which is contrary to Section 43 of the Electricity Act, 2003 and requested to direct the respondents to consider the petitioner's application and pass appropriate orders.

4. In view of the same, the Writ Petition is disposed of at the admission stage directing the respondents to consider the application filed by the petitioner dated 17.02.2023 as per law, and provide power supply or pass appropriate orders on the application filed by the petitioner, within four (4) weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order. There shall be no order as to costs.

Miscellaneous applications, if any pending, shall also stand closed.

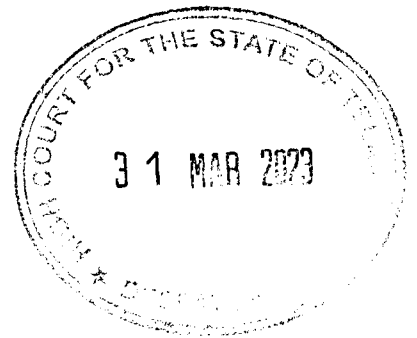
