Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to declare the action of the respondents in not considering their claim for promotion to the post of School Assistant on the ground that they are repatriated to their parent district under G.O.Ms.No.610 dated 30.12.1985 even though they are fully eligible and qualified and number of their juniors were considered for promotion is illegal arbitrary and discriminatory, unconstitutional consequently to direct the respondent to consider the claim of the applicants for promotion to the post of School Assistant by following the Proc.Rc.No.2319/SerIV-2/2013 dated 04 07.2015 on par with their juniors with all consequential benefits.
