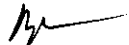
O R D E R:

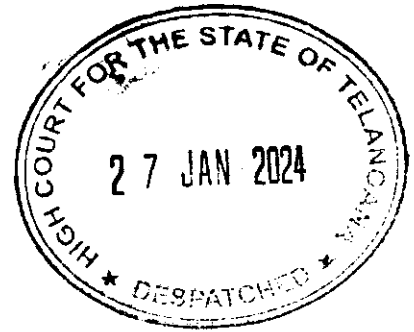
