JUDGMENT:

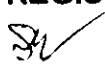
Learned Counsel appearing for the appellant seeks permission to withdraw the petition and made an endorsement on the Court bundle.

3. Miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, in this petition shall stand closed.

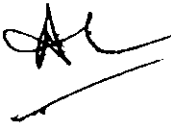
