ORDER:

The contempt case is filed seeking to punish the respondent under Sections 10 to 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for deliberate and willful disobedience in implementing the order passed by this Court in W.P.No.40523 of 2016, dated 23.11.2016.

2. No representation on behalf of the petitioner in the morning and afternoon sessions. Heard learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue appearing on behalf of respondent.

3. This Court while disposing the writ petition on 23.11.2016, directed the 3rd respondent to dispose of the representation dated 01.02.2016 made by the petitioner seeking to enter his name in the revenue records in respect of the land admeasuring Ac.0.31 guntas in Sy.No.1343/A situated at Choppadandi Village and Mandal, Karimnagar District, in accordance with law, at the earliest.

4. Learned Assistant Government Pleader basing on the instructions submits that, the respondent complied with the order passed by this Court in W.P.No.40523 of 2016, dated 23.11.2016.

5. In view of the above submission, no further adjudication is required.

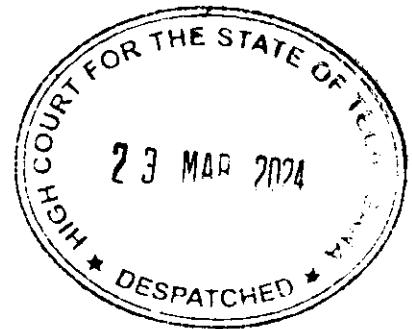
