This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr.P.C.') by the petitioners-accused Nos.1 and 2 to quash the proceedings initiated against them in C.C.No.6698 of 2022 pending on the file of learned I Additional Junior Civil Judge-cum-IX Additional Metropolitan Magistrate, Ranga Reddy District at Kukatpally, filed for the offences punishable under Section 498-A of Indian Penal Code.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent No.1 - State. Perused the record.
