Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of MANDAMUS declaring the inaction of the official respondents to register the complaint dated 17-04-2023 of the petitioner against

the respondents 6 to 8 till date, that the acts on part of the official respondents clearly constitute offences punishable Under Sections 420, 386, 343, 326, 447, 506 and r/w. 34 of IPC is arbitrary, illegal, capricious and violative of provisions of Cr.P.C as well as the guidelines issued by the Constitutional Bench of Apex Court and consequently to direct the respondents 2 to 5 to adhere to the guidelines laid down by the Apex Court in registering and investigation and register the case against the respondents 6 to 8 and conduct fair enquiry forthwith.
