Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings in C.C No. 6593 of 2022 before the IX Addl. Metropolitan Magistrate Ranga Reddy District at Kukatpally, pending disposal of the criminal petition.

This Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Vishal Kumar Jain, Advocate for the Petitioner and the Public Prosecutor on behalf of the Respondent No.1 and of the Respondent No. 2 not appearing in person or through his counsel.

The Court made the following: **ORDER**

CRIMINAL PETITION No.4253 OF 2023

ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr.P.C.') by the petitioners-accused Nos. 4 and 5 to quash the proceedings against them in C.C. No.6593 of 2022 pending on the file of learned IX Additional Metropolitan Magistrate, Rangareddy District at Kukatpally. The offence alleged against the petitioners are under Sections 498A, 406, 323 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC') and Sections 3 and 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners - accused Nos. 4 and 5 and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent - State. Perused the record.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners confined his prayer to dispense with the personal appearance of petitioners - accused Nos.4 and 5.

4. Considering the submission of learned counsel for the petitioners, the attendance of the petitioners-accused Nos. 4 and 5 is dispensed with in C.C. No. 6593 of 2022 pending on

the file of learned IX Additional Metropolitan Magistrate, Rangareddy District at Kukatpally, when represented by their counsel on record. The attendance of the petitioners is dispensed with subject to filing an affidavit by the petitioners stating that in their absence the proceedings conducted by their counsel will not be disputed by them in any manner and shall not dispute their identity also. However, the petitioners shall appear before the learned Magistrate as and when their presence is required. In the event of failure of the petitioners to appear when the Court directs, this order dispensing their attendance shall stand cancelled.

5. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is disposed of.

Miscellaneous applications pending, if any, shall stand closed.
