ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking to call for the records pertaining to C.C.No.675 of 2011 on the file of Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Hyderabad for the offence under Section 340 IPC and quash the same.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner as well as the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor appearing for respondent-State.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the cause in the present criminal petition does not survive for adjudication. Therefore, no further orders are required and hence seeks to dismiss the same as infructuous.
