CRIMINAL PETITION No.4620 of 2021

ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr.P.C.') by the petitioners/A1 & A2 to quash the proceedings against them in C.C.No.973 of 2020 on the file of XXIV Additional Metropolitan Magistrate, Cyberabad at Hayathnagar. The offences alleged against the petitioners are under Sections 447 and 427 of the Indian Penal Code.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners/A1 & A2, and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent-State.

3. On perusal of the facts and circumstances of the case, petitioners/A2 have to undergo the trial to prove their defence and the same cannot be considered and quash the proceedings.

4. Accordingly, there are no grounds and the Criminal Petition is dismissed. However, in the event of the

petitioners/A1 & A2 filing an application under Section 205 of Cr.P.C., to be represented by a counsel, the same shall be considered by the Trial Court, by imposing conditions, without hindrance to the trial.

Miscellaneous applications pending, if any, shall stand closed.
