Heard Mr. A V V S Bhujanga Rao, learned counsel for the petitioner, learned Government Pleader for Services-I, and Mr.K.Balakrishna, learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.2.

The present Contempt Case is filed complaining violation of the orders of this Court dated 13.09.2022 passed in W.P.No.3864 of 2014 directing the respondents to pay Rs.5,33,429/- recovered from the petitioner, on proper acknowledgment, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a copy of the order.

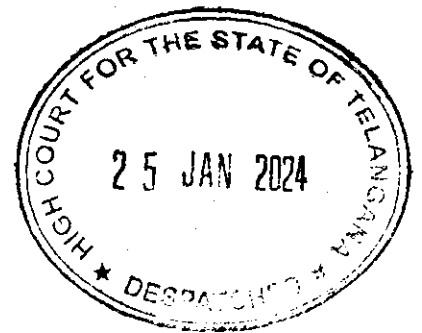
