ORDER:

The contempt case is filed seeking to punish the respondent under Sections 10 to 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for deliberate and willful disobedience in implementing the order passed by this Court in W.P.No.7037 of 2014, dated 01.02.2016.

2. Heard Sri Y.Neelakanta Reddy, learned counsel representing Sri V.Ravi Kiran Rao, learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue appearing on behalf of respondent.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that inspite of specific direction issued by this Court on 01.02.2016, the respondent not complied with the order.
4. Per contra, learned Assistant Government Pleader submits that, the respondent considered the claim of the petitioner/Gram Panchayat and allotted the revenue share in

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respect of the land's allotted to the petitioner/Gram Panchayat to a tune of Rs.56,64,798/- from 2001-2002 to 2016- 2017.

5. In view of the specific averments made by the respondent in para 6 of the counter affidavit, no further adjudication is required.

6. Accordingly, the Contempt Case is closed. However, the petitioner is granted liberty to avail the remedies as are available under law, if so advised.

Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand closed.

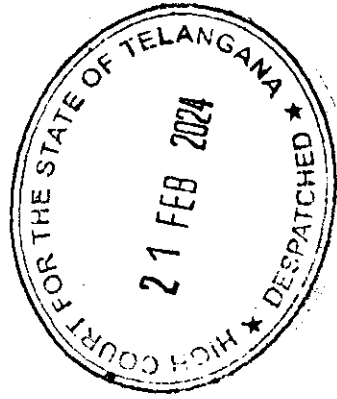
