Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order, or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus by declaring that the action of the respondent in not concluding the Departmental enquiry against the Petitioner even though the finding of the Enquiry Officer is held in favour of the Petitioner as wholly illegal, arbitrary, unconstitutional and violative of Article 14, 16 and 21 of Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents to drop the charge memo dated 28-06-2016 and declare the probation of the Petitioner in the Category of Regional Transport Officer and further direct the respondents to consider the case of the Petitioner for promotion to the post of Deputy Transport Commissioner in the interest of justice.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to

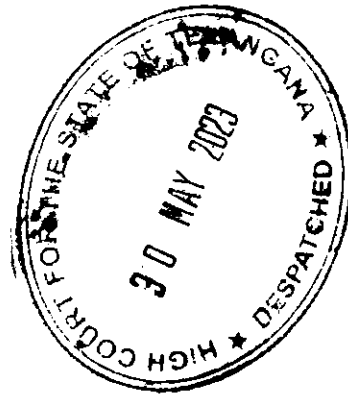
