This Court by order 28.04.2023 directed the trial Court to be complete the trial within time frame of four months. Learned Principal Junior Civil Judge – cum XI Additional Metropolitan Magistrate, Cyberabad at Rajendranagar addressed a letter, dated 28.10.2023 stating that due to various reasons, the trial could not be completed within time frame fixed by this Court.

Considering the facts of the case, this Court deems it appropriate to extend the time for a period of three (03) months to dispose of the case.

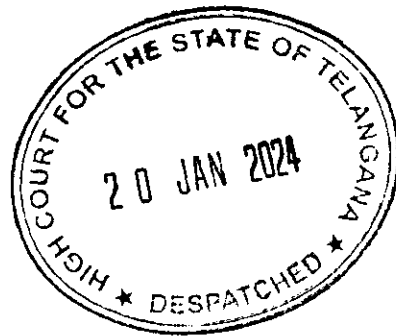
